

SCHOOL OVERVIEW

Tuition-free public school with rigorous online curriculum and high expectations.

- Certified instructors teach online lessons, grade assignments and provide support.
- Students can complete coursework virtually anywhere a computer and the Internet is accessible.
- Grades are determined by student performance on teacher-graded activities and computer-graded assignments, quizzes, and exams within each course. Students may view grades for each assignment through the grade book.
- Grades K-2 usually spend about 3 hours a day online and do the rest of their day offline. Grade 3 usually spends about 4 hours a day online. Grades 4-5 spend about 4 to 5 hours a day online.

POLICIES/PROCEDURES

School administrators and teachers monitor daily student engagement and work submissions.

- Students conduct themselves with honor and academic integrity. Turnitin.com is used to protect the academic integrity of submitted work.
- Students spend 1 hour per class, per day on coursework and homework. The school week operates Monday through Friday; however, access to courses is available on weekends and holidays.
- Attendance must be submitted and verified daily.
- Failure to start and complete coursework will result in truancy consideration and withdrawal.

PARENT/GUARDIAN INVOLVEMENT

Collaboration of the parent, student, and teacher is absolutely key for student success.

- Monitor/check in with your student daily regarding work completion.
- Provide and enforce a regular schooling routine.
- Support study skills as a priority for learning.
- Verify your students' weekly attendance & ensure students are meeting attendance requirements.
- Communicate with your student's teachers regarding absences, questions, and concerns.
