

# Graduation Details

Congratulations! We are excited to celebrate with you at the **Primavera Online School Class of 2026 Graduation Ceremony** on July 8, 2026, at:  
Arizona Financial Theatre, 400 W Washington St., Phoenix, AZ 85003

We will have 2 ceremony times: 11:00am and 3:00pm. Please clarify with your graduate which ceremony they are walking in.

## Arrival Time

All graduates must arrive 2 hours early for check-in and ceremony preparation. The student entry is on the west side of the building near the corner of 5<sup>th</sup> and Adams.

## Attire & Graduation Cap Decorations

Graduates should wear business casual attire underneath their graduation gown. We recommend wearing comfortable shoes, as graduates will be standing and walking throughout portions of the ceremony. For safety purposes, heels should be no higher than 3 inches.

Graduates are welcome to decorate their graduation caps, provided all decorations follow Primavera's graduation cap decoration guidelines. Graduates whose cap decorations do not meet these guidelines may be asked to remove or modify them before participating in the ceremony.

## Guest Confirmation

Graduates may bring up to 6 guests unless otherwise requested and confirmed by the graduation planning team.

## Guest Arrival Information

Please note that while graduates are required to arrive 2 hours early, the venue will not open to guests until 1 hour prior. Seating will begin 15 minutes before the ceremony starts.

To ensure a comfortable experience, we encourage parents, guardians, and guests to plan accordingly. Due to the summer heat, guests may wish to wait at a nearby restaurant, coffee shop, or in their vehicle until the venue opens. Please share this information with all guests attending the ceremony so they can plan their arrival appropriately.

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## Ceremony Length

The graduation ceremony is expected to last approximately 90 minutes. Following the ceremony, graduates and guests should plan to meet outside the theater, as the venue must be cleared promptly. As a reminder, diplomas will be mailed out.

## Venue Information

### Bag Policy

Bags up to 12" x 6" x 12" are allowed in the venue. All bags will be searched prior to entry. Bags that are not clear will be subject to additional search. We encourage guests to bring only essential items to expedite entry through security. **Remember- no balloons, glass (vases) or noise makers are permitted.**

### Water Bottles

Guests may bring one sealed bottle of water or an empty water bottle, per person into the venue. There will be refill stations inside the venue.

### Concessions

Limited concessions will be available for purchase inside the theatre.

### Accessible Seating

Guests needing accessible seating should visit Guest Services, located on the east side of the lobby, upon arrival. They will escort you or direct you to the appropriate seating area. Accessible seating is available for guests who use wheelchairs or require mobility accommodations. This designated seating area includes space for the guest requiring accommodations and one companion seat.

### Sign Language Interpretation

For guests who are deaf or hard of hearing, a sign language interpreter will be present on stage throughout the ceremony. The interpreter will also be displayed on the theatre's large video screens and will be visible from all seating areas in the venue.

### Nursing Infants

A private suite will be available upstairs for families with nursing infants.
